I also agree to comply with the following prohibitions. If I violate any prohibitions, I agree to delete any footage or photographs I have taken and leave Kawasaki Velodrome.

Prohibitions

(1) Locations where filming/photography are prohibited

- During race events at the velodrome, filming and photography are prohibited from locations where it may interfere with the races.
*This includes filming and taking photographs directly beside the finish line, and on or atop the chain-link fence.

(2) Purpose of filming/photography

- Filming and photography are permitted for personal enjoyment only. *1
- Filming and photography for commercial purposes are prohibited.

(3) Disruptive behaviors

- Pointing a camera at other visitors, or filming footage and/or taking photographs in which individuals can be identified
- Filming and photography that may constitute an infringement of portrait rights or copyrights
- Filming and photography using a flash or other lighting equipment *2
- Filming and photography for a long period of time using tripods or other freestanding equipment
- Filming and photography of cyclists practicing on the track without their permission during off-track betting events
- Filming and photography using drones or other remotely operated devices
- Posting or distributing footage or photographs online or through other media
- Using footage or photographs to dispute race results

*1 You may be asked to remove any footage or photographs that you post online or elsewhere if they are deemed socially inappropriate.

*2 You may be subject to punishment under Article 64 of the Bicycle Racing Act, which states: "Any person who, through deception or force, commits an act that may compromise the fairness of bicycle racing shall be punished by imprisonment for up to three years or a fine of up to 2 million yen."
